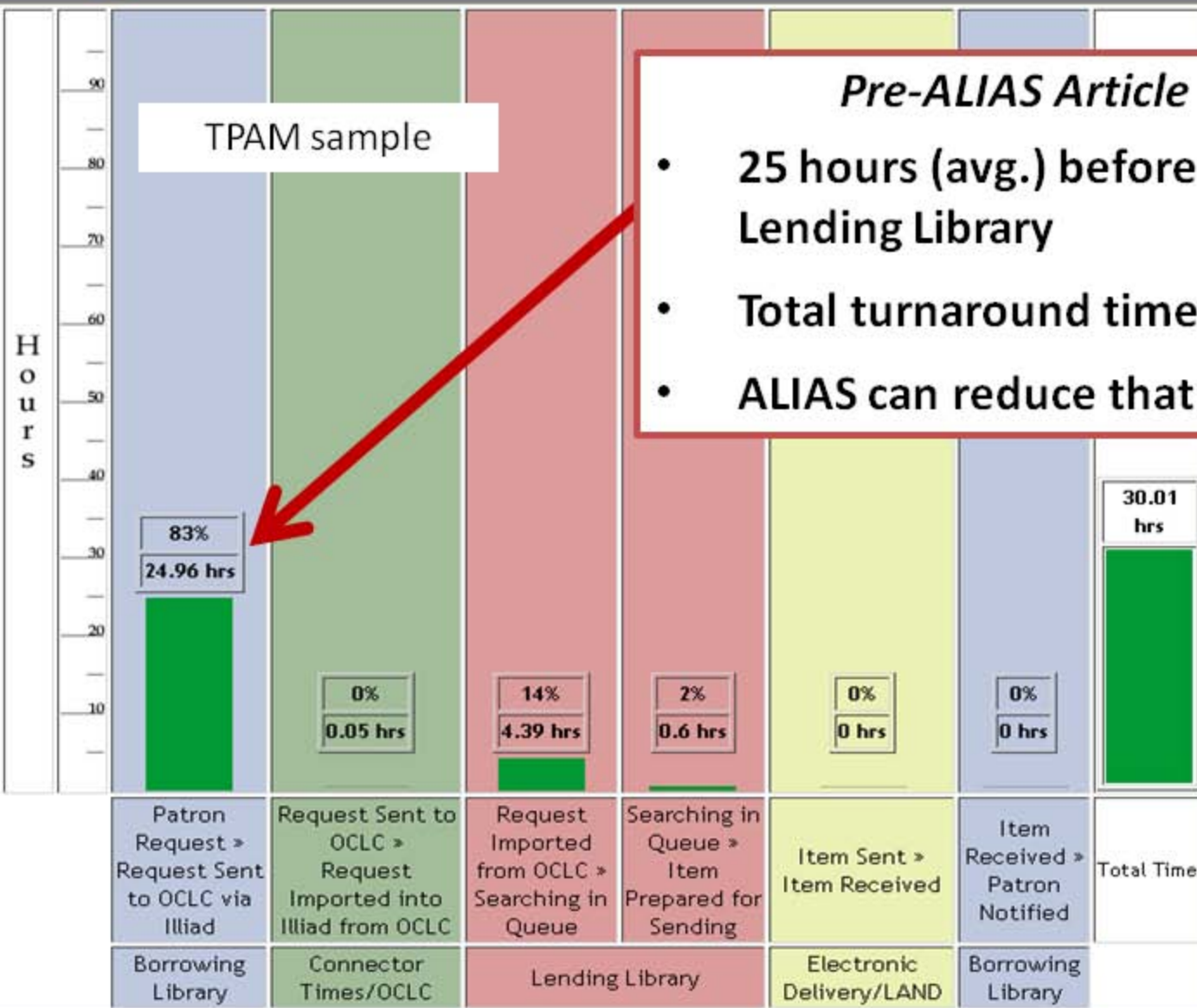

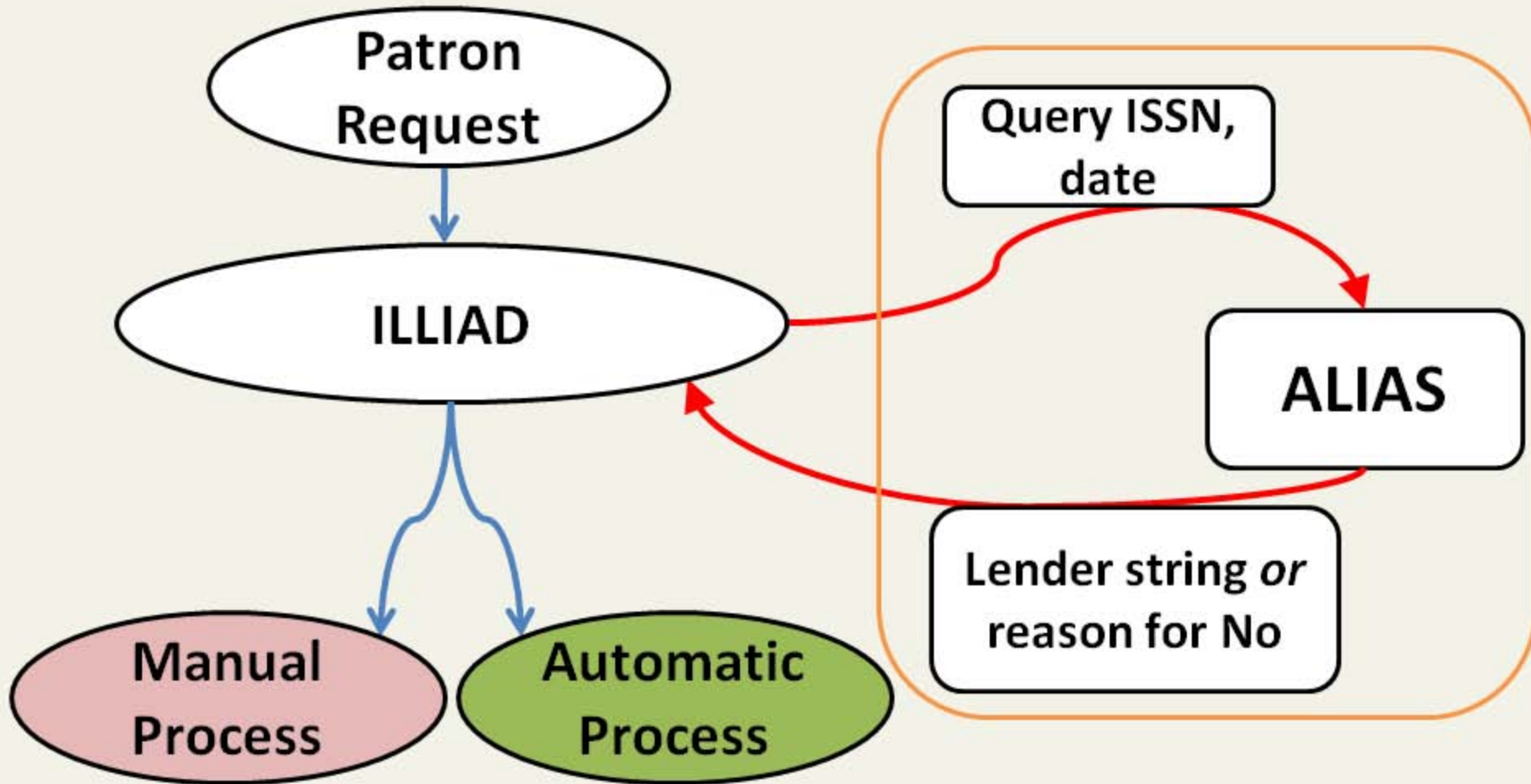

**Pre-ALIAS Article Borrowing**

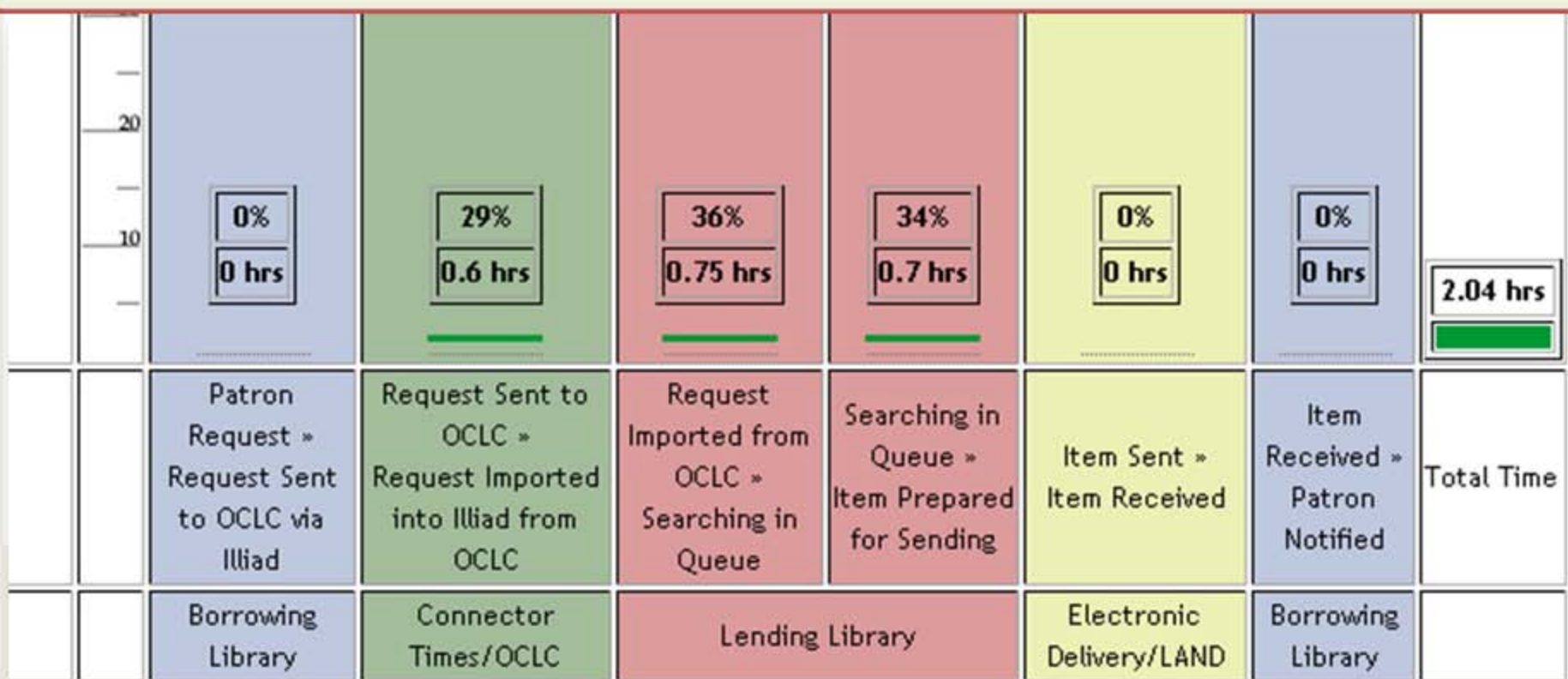
- 25 hours (avg.) before requests sent to Lending Library
